Entry Formalities for travellers:

Indian Nationals -

Entry Permit for Nepal:

Indian nationals do not require any visa for Nepal. A permit will be issued at the entry point on production of a passport (with a minimum validity of 6 months from the date of departure) or Voter ID (only valid document for issuing the Nepal Entry permit). The traveller should also carry photocopy of the travel documents and 04 passport size photographs. For Children, original Birth certificate in English and student ID is required. ADHAR CARD/ PAN CARD / DRIVING LICENSE IS NOT A VALID DOCUMENT TO TRAVEL TO NEPAL BY AIR.

For Other Nationals

A visa for Nepal can be obtained on arrival at the Tribhuvan international airport, Kathmandu. It can also be obtained at border entry points in Kakarbhitta, Birgunj, Bhairahawa, Nepalgunj, Mahendranagar on the Nepal-India border and Kodari on the Nepalchina border.

Outside of Nepal, visa can also be obtained at the nearest Nepal embassy or diplomatic mission. It is recommended that the visas are obtained prior to coming so that you can avoid standing in long queues. Visa can be renewed at department of immigration, Kalikasthan, Kathmandu.

Requirements

- A valid passport which is valid for 6 months for date of departure in Nepal and one passport -size photo with a light background.
- Visa can be obtained only through payment of cash in the following currency: euro, swiss franc, pound sterling, us dollar, australian dollar, canadian dollar, hong kong dollar, singapore dollar and japanese yen. Credit card, indian currency and Nepali currency are not accepted as payment of visa fee
